GENERAL ORDER OF THE
PRESIDING JUDGE

16 The ability to pay tool is not intended to be used to request fine reductions after a
17 judgment has been entered, including if the case was disposed of by bail forfeiture. It is
18 hereby ordered that the clerk's office shall reject that filing.

19 This general order applies to all traffic infraction cases, in all courthouses, where
20 the case was previously disposed of by bail forfeiture.

21 This order is effective January 1, 2026, and supersedes all previous general
22 orders entitled *Rejection of Electronically Filed Ability to Pay (E-AtP) Requests for*
23 *Traffic Infraction Citations Disposed of by Bail Forfeiture* issued by previous Presiding
24 Judges. This order shall remain in effect until December 31, 2027.
