

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

**Q1.** What is the current status of the labor agreements with both bargaining units (Teamsters and SEIU)?

**A1.** Both contracts are set to expire in September 2028

**Q2.** When do you anticipate negotiations for successor MOUs with Teamsters and SEIU starting?

**A2.** Early 2028

**Q3.** Does the Court have a preference for in-person negotiations or virtual negotiations via Zoom, Teams, etc.?

**A3.** In-Person

**Q4.** Were the last negotiations with Teamsters and SEIU conducted in-person or virtually?

**A4.** **Most Recent Negotiations – 2025 (Contract Extensions):**

- **Teamsters:** 2 in-person meetings
- **SEIU:** 3 in-person meetings  
*(No virtual sessions conducted in 2025)*

**Prior Negotiations – 2022:**

- **SEIU:** 2 virtual meetings, 8 in-person meetings
- **Teamsters:** 10 in-person meetings
