SAN BERNARDINO SUPERIOR COURT WELCOMES NEW JUDGE DOUGLAS K. MANN

SAN BERNARDINO, CA— On March 25, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the appointment of Douglas Kent Mann to a judgeship in the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino.

The Governor's office released the following statements:

Douglas Kent Mann, 56, of Claremont, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the San Bernardino Superior Court. Mann has been a Partner and Attorney at Walker & Mann LLP since 2007. He was a Partner and Attorney at Snyder, Walker & Mann LLP from 2006 to 2007 and at Elliot, Snyder & Reid LLP and predecessor firms from 1992 to 2006. Mann earned a Juris Doctor degree from Rutgers Law School. He fills the vacancy of a new position created on September 24, 2019.

Presiding Judge Michael A. Sachs said of the appointment and selection, "we are pleased with the Governor's appointment of Judge Mann who will be a great addition to our bench."
